War Department for permit to erect a High Level Bridge clearing river traffic and all grade crossings on both sides of Sacramento River, the point designated being W Street or vicinity (exact location not positively determined).

You have doubtless observed through the Press, reference to our Bridge project, all favorable and enthusiastic.
