Harvest began with placing canvas "sheets" under trees to catch the falling nuts.

Almonds were knocked off the trees onto "sheets" and shoveled into sacks.



Moving the "sheets" by hand was difficult work.



The pulpy outer hull was removed by hand or machine.



Hulling by hand was tedious work.



Mechanical hullers
eventually relieved
growers from hulling by
hand.



The nuts were spread on wooden trays to dry, then resacked for shipment.



Sacks of almonds were hauled to warehouses for grading and shipping.
